Trustee Cashman

- Verizon has agreed to remove poles at the rate of 5 days/month.
- Chenango St, between the I-88 bridge and Fenton line will be kept patched until there is discussion with Broome County and NYS DOT regarding paving.

Trustee Aagre

- hydrants need to be pressure tested for insurance purposes.
- FEMA has approved reconstruction of the tennis courts for an amount not to exceed \$156,000.
- The unused meter pit at State St/Bromley Ave is to be filled in for \$2500-\$3000.

Mayor Burke

- The elevator project will include \$2995 for air monitoring during asbestos removal
- Request for handicapped parking on Kinney Ave. There would have to be a spot on both sides of the street and would be in effect all year. The Mayor will clarify the situation with the resident before proceeding.
- NYSDOT patched the hole at Chenango St/Grant St and the barrel has been removed. The Village does not own any barrels, it was the property of NYSDOT.
- The situation on Hillcrest Ave was created by the parking of a Postal vehicle. CV Schools is continuing to monitor the situation and the Fire Department will be driving trucks down the street several times.
- \$8900 has been received from the Binghamton/JC Joint Sewage Treatment Plant for the years of 2008, 2009 and 2010. The money will be deposited in the Sewer Fund.
- Engineer Lake will be requested to look at a long-term plan to connect the water line that dead ends at State/Bromley with the City line that comes up State Street or to put a line up Bromley to connect to Chenango St.
