1. Spring newsletter will be mailed with water bills on 2/28/15.
2. Treasurer Miller reported that the total assessed value of properties in the Village has increased which will allow the tax rate for 2015-2016 to remain about the same while still generating some increased revenue. Retirement system rates have decreased and there are less employees in the retirement system resulting in budget decrease in that area. Public hearing to be scheduled for the April 2015 meeting.
3. Treasurer Miller reported that Chase Bank is now charging fees so she will be looking to move accounts to another bank.
4. Electricity use is increased in Village Hall. Everyone is reminded to conserve.
5. Trustee Harding has looked into markers for the 63 hydrants in the Village. The cost would be about \$1200 dollars and would allow Fire & DPW to locate hydrants under the snow.
