During the month of June the Port Dickinson Fire Department responded to 14 calls for assistance, these calls are broken down as follows: 6 Fire calls 8 Medical calls, they had 8 Calls in the Village, 5 Calls in the Town of Dickinson, 1 Calls in the Town of Fenton. The Fire Department offered, 6 Hours of training in the month totaling 42 man hours.

The Port Dickinson Police Department responded to 117 complaints for assistance, gave mutual aid 10 times, They wrote 9 Traffic Tickets and 1 Parking tickets, they made two penal law arrests. (Violation harassment)

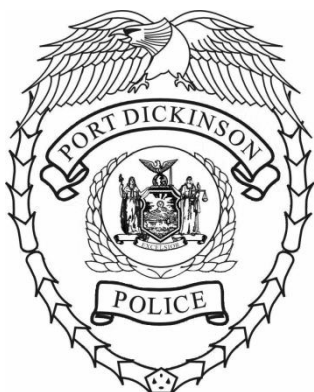
NEW BUSINESS:
